Use of Video Cameras

The MAX Charter School shall authorize the use of video cameras on Board property, buildings, and/or vehicles to ensure the health, welfare, and safety of all staff, students, and visitors to the schools, and to safeguard Board facilities and equipment. Video cameras may be used in locations as deemed appropriate by the school, but placement shall not be allowed in bathrooms and/or dressing rooms. Video recordings may become a part of a student's educational record or an employee's personnel record. The School Board shall comply with all applicable state or federal statutes related to record maintenance and retention. Students or employees viewed violating school rules and regulations shall be disciplined, in accordance with Board regulations, up to and including expulsion/termination. Action may be taken against visitors viewed breaking regulations, including notification of law enforcement officials.
