Dear Valued Parent(s) and Guardian(s),

I'd like to provide you with more information regarding the mandated school closure due to COVID-19.

- **Communication** between the school and home will be via text and email. Updates and documents can also be found on our school's website, www.maxcharter.org.
- Teachers are reporting to school on Tuesday, March 17th and will begin creating **Distance Learning** assignments for your child to complete while away from school. The teachers will be communicating with you via email/text and Google Classroom. Videos, instruction, resource links, etc. will be compiled and posted to assist you in facilitating your child's distance learning. Students will be held accountable to complete this work and will be graded accordingly. Parents, we urge you to encourage and monitor your child's at-home learning. The students have worked so hard this year and are making progress; we do not want them to fall behind. Our plan is to disseminate these assignments by Wednesday afternoon.
- **State testing dates** have been altered. The testing window is scheduled to open on Monday, April 27th.
- **3rd 9 Weeks Report Cards** will be mailed out on Wednesday, March 18th. Contact the school office if your address has recently changed.
- At this time, **MAX will not be providing food through Revolution Foods**. Some school districts are providing food to ALL children 18 years of age and younger, free of charge. If interested in taking advantage of this service, please contact the parish school board office in your area.
- Please be advised that as of now our **Spring Break will remain as scheduled**; therefore, students will return to school on Monday, April 20th.
