Dear Valued Parent(s) and Guardian(s),

I am hoping you and your family are having a restful summer, enjoying activities that we no longer take for granted after last year. The staff at MAX has been gearing up for a new year with anticipation. I am excited about finally meeting you and your students.

- A meeting for the parents of new students is scheduled for Tuesday, August 3, at 4:00.
- Students return on Friday, August 6th.
- We are asking that each student pay a \$125.00 school supply and technology fee due by Friday, August 13th. The school will purchase all needed school supplies. If paying by check, please make checks payable to The MAX Charter School.
- Review the Student Dress Code, which can be found on our website at [www.maxcharter.org](http://www.maxcharter.org) and monitor daily your child's adherence to it. Only SOLID BLACK jackets may be worn, belt must be black, brown, or khaki, and TENNIS SHOES must be SOLID BLACK. School bags no longer need to be clear or mesh.
- Students are not allowed to have cell phones at school. Only special permission, to bring a cell phone to school, will be granted to students who ride the public transit bus or to students with exceptional circumstances. Call the front office to request the form which must be completed to obtain approval from an administrative staff member.
- Before and After School Child Care will be available beginning August 6th. Details and a list of fees will be sent home on the first day. Pre-registration is not required but you may call the school or send a note with your child if he/she will be staying for After Care on the first day. Before Care begins at 7:00 AM and After Care ends at 5:30 PM.
- LEAP Test Scores have not yet been released this summer. They will be uploaded in the Parent Portal of JPams. A text message will be sent to notify you of when these are released. Parents of 4th and 8th graders who didn't meet proficiency requirements, will be obligated to attend a meeting with administration and teachers to discuss an Individual Academic Plan. Parents will be notified of these meetings accordingly.
