## Bullying Policy Threats, Bullying (including Cyberbullying, Intimidation, Harassment and Hazing)

The School Board for The MAX Charter Alternative School affirms and supports the mandates of La. R.S 17:416:13, and as amended, also known as the "Tesa Middlebrook Anti-Bullying Act" of 2012 (Act 861). The School Board further supports Act 861's call for timely and effectively addressing all forms of bullying.

Students who exhibit bullying behavior will be issued a Bullying Caution Slip and may have disciplinary consequences. After three (3) Bullying Caution Slips, the school administration will follow state guidelines for reprimanding and/or reporting of bullying behavior.
